

SAFETY NOTICE

Before starting the installation process, ensure the wall construction is suitable and can support the weight of the mirror. The wall plugs supplied are only suitable for solid stone/brick walls. For plasterboard walls use specialist wall plugs along with supplementary wall strengthening as units can be very heavy. Seek advice from a specialist about the suitability of fixings to be used.







Wear suitable eye protection when drilling. Take care when using power tools near water - the use of a residual current device (RCD) is recommended. Beware of hidden pipes or cables. Take care when drilling tiled surfaces as the drill might slip. Use a piece of masking tape to prevent the drill from wandering.

WARNINGS

Do not strike glass components with hard or pointed items. Do not place very hot or very cold items against or in close proximity to glass surfaces unless an adequately thick insulation material is used to prevent such items coming in contact with the glass.

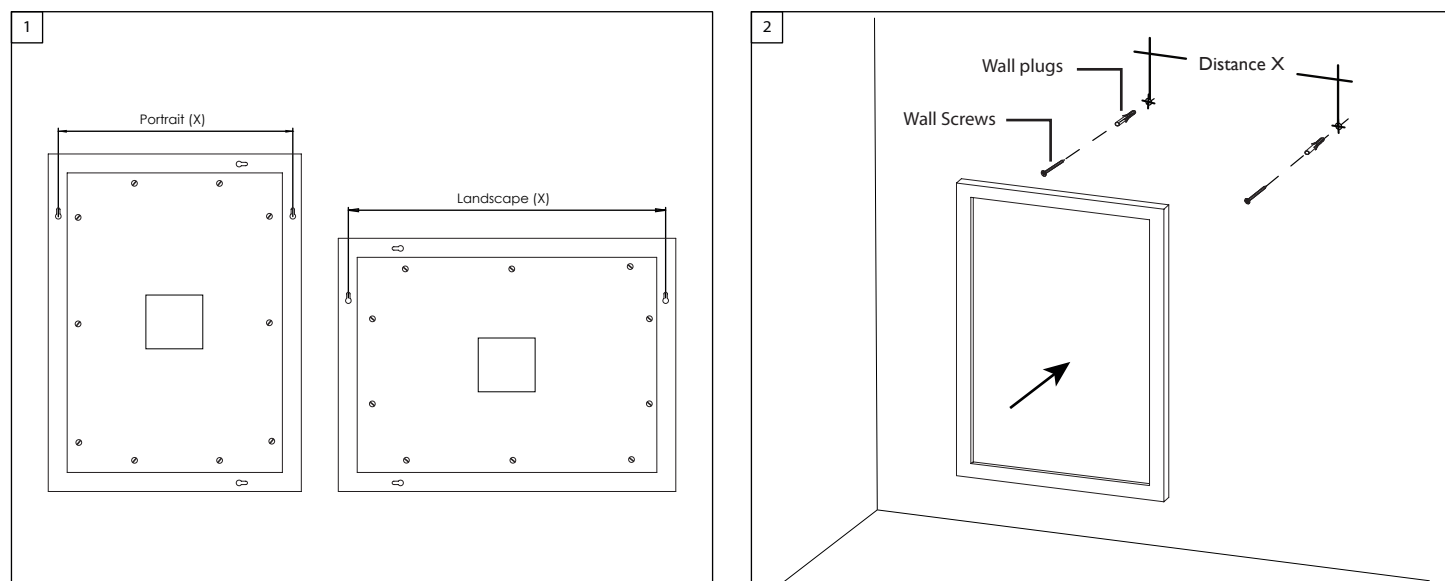
As with all wooden furniture, this product should be treated with care.

 <p>Wipe away any water splashes or condensation after use. Excessive exposure to water will deteriorate the furniture.</p>	 <p>Do not scrub or scour</p>
 <p>All bathrooms should be well ventilated with a suitable extractor fan.</p>	 <p>Do not use abrasive cleaning agents</p>
 <p>Clean with a soft damp cloth only.</p>	
 <p>For removal of lime scale deposits use a suitable proprietary cleaner. If necessary test on an inconspicuous area first.</p>

MIRROR AFTERCARE INSTRUCTIONS.



- 1) Measure the distance (X) between the keyhole slots on the back of the mirror.
- 2) Mark out the fixing screw positions on the wall using a pencil to the desired height, ensuring they are spaced at distance (X).
- 3) Drill the marked out positions and fit the wall plugs accordingly. Fix the screw into position, leaving a small amount of the screw head proud of the wall for hanging.
- 4) To remove the mirror, the mirror should first be lifted and then pulled away from the wall.
